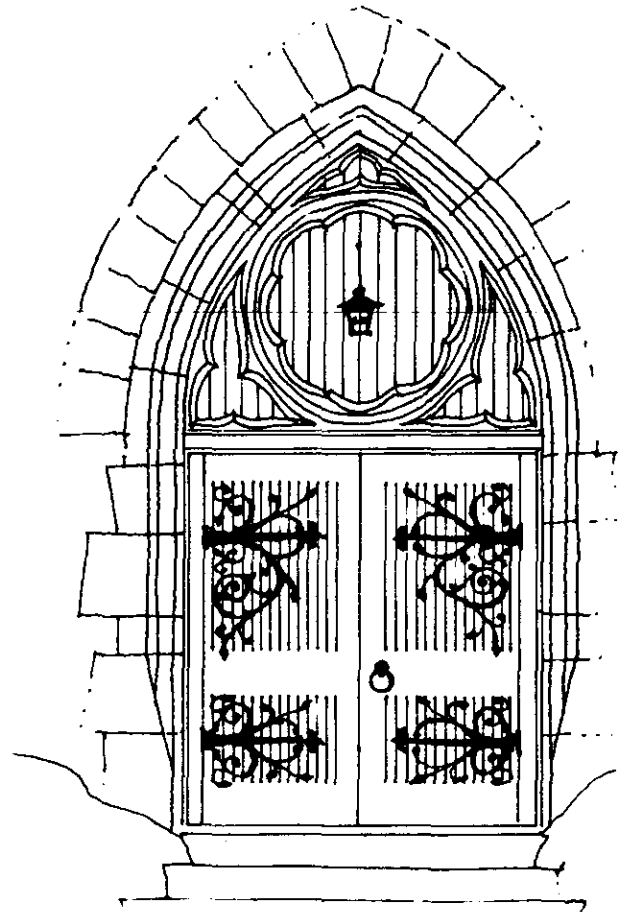
PLACE: Christ Church Cathedral

APRIL MEETINGS

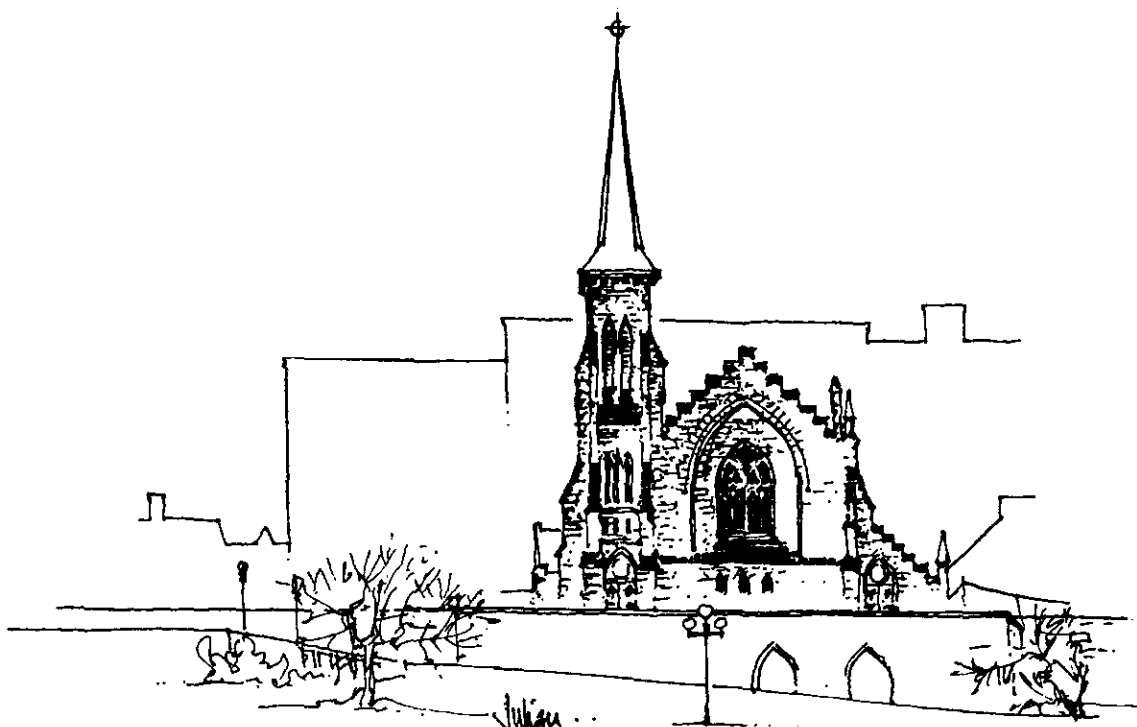
